Trustee Report: Amy Snow reported the Trustees are working with an architect for space usage. Parking signs: The Trustees are ordering 2 “no parking” signs. They will be white with red wording saying “no parking or you will be towed”. The Town will install them. It will be \$50 or less for the 2 signs. A unanimous vote was taken to pay for these signs.

New Business:

Connie Brown asked about our prior discussion of making a second “book nook” area in the front entrance, under the shelves & bulletin boards for the FOL to sell more books. Nothing has been done about this and Connie was asked to investigate.
