







Our MWV STEM Expo Camp was held over February vacation week in coordination with the Mt Washington Observatory and Tin Mountain. Participating students learned about the scientific method and engineering design process before creating and testing their own hypotheses. Library staff completed a CPR/AED training at their February staff meeting. Following the training, the Library has added infant sized CPR masks to the emergency supplies in the Children's Room and has purchased two anti-choking devices to be stored at the service desks.
