

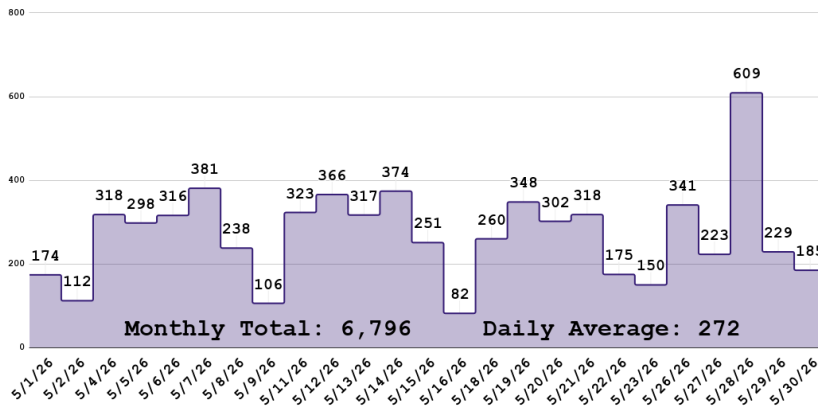

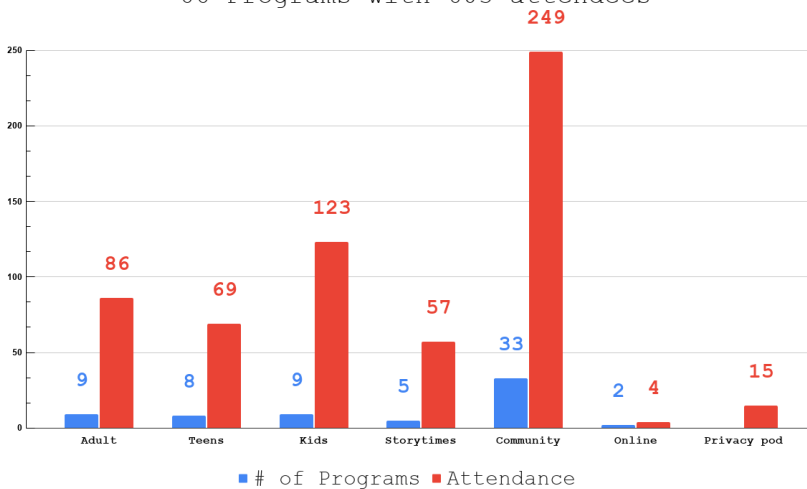
Tessa received a CLIF grant to cover the cost of NH author and illustrator Marty Kelley for the Summer Reading kick-off program.

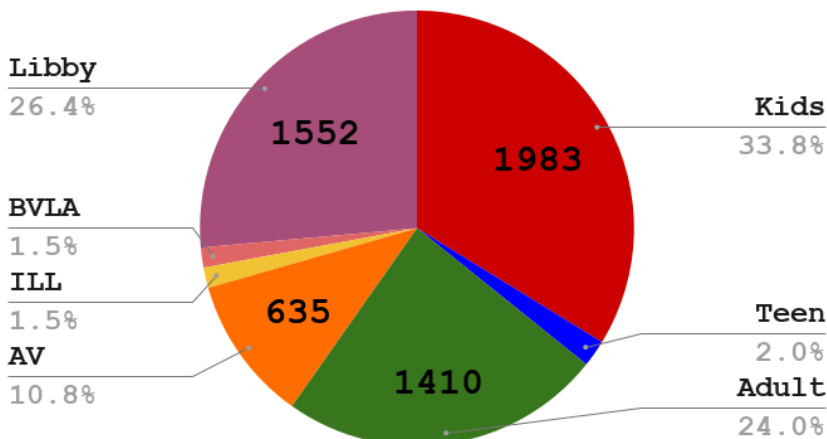
