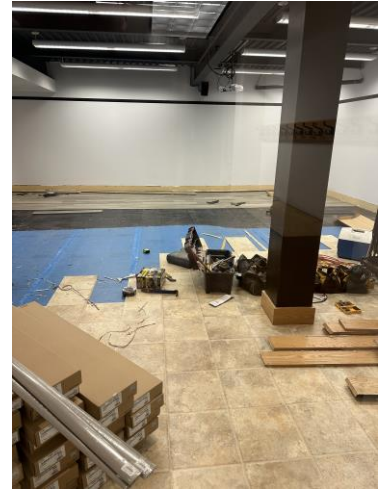


## August 2024 - Programs

We have moved forward with upgrading to a new Porter Office Machine copier that is capable of black and white, color, and WiFi printing, as well as an e-fax option.
