June, 2026 - 7520 Library Visits

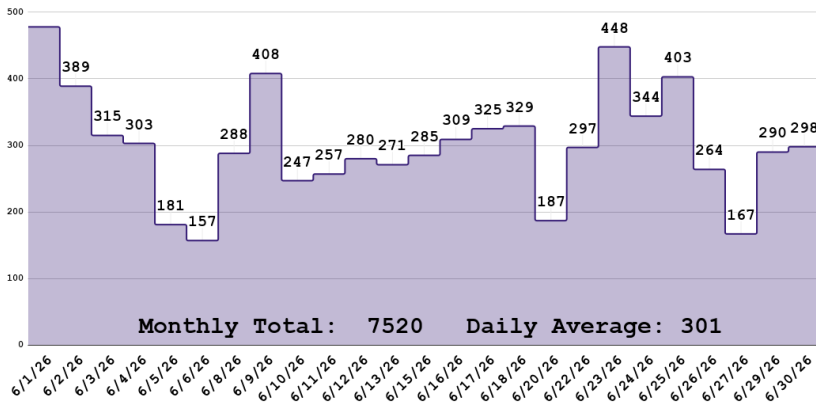
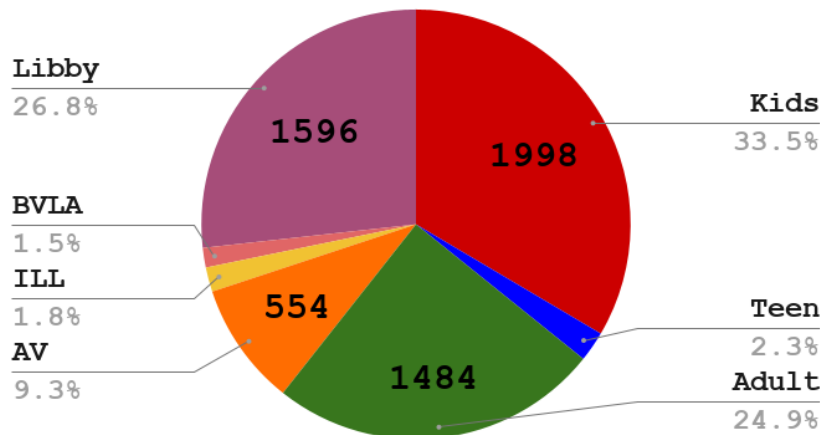

The Conway Public Library celebrated its 125th Anniversary on June 13 with a full day of community events honoring the library's history while looking toward its future. Activities included the sale of commemorative library cards to support restoration of the historic entrance, opportunities for visitors to sign the 125-year time capsule book, a special Peter Rabbit-themed story hour, a rededication ceremony, historical tours, a Conway Historical Society exhibit, and a library trivia scavenger hunt. The celebration drew strong community participation and reinforced the institution's enduring role as a cornerstone of the Mount Washington Valley community for the past 125 years.

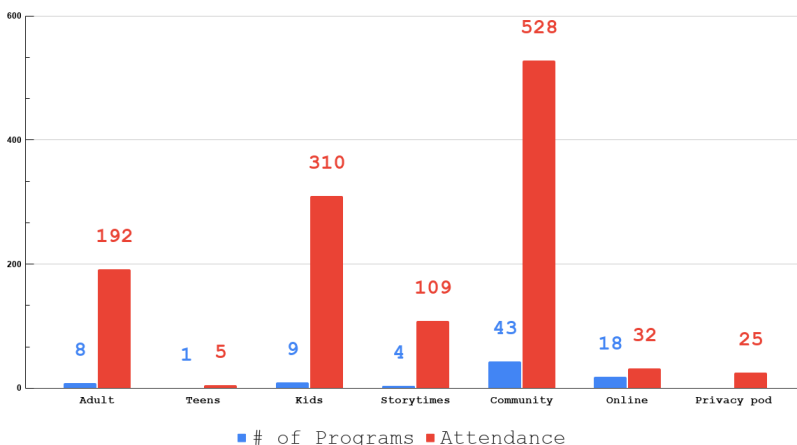


June, 2026 - Circulation: 5966 items

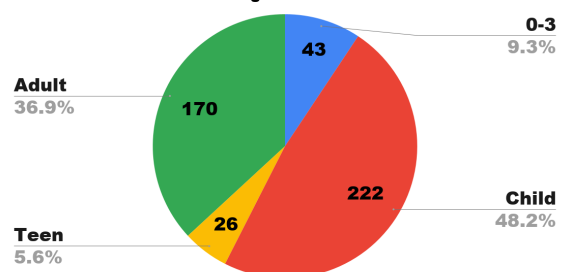


June 2026 Programs

2026 Summer Reading Total Registrations = 461



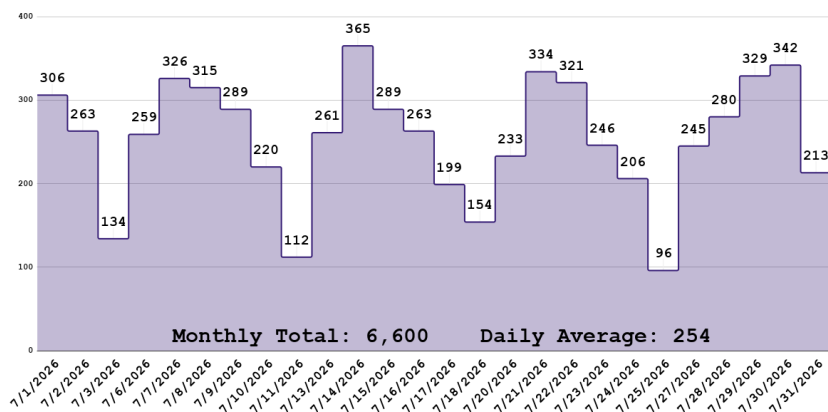


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July, 2026 - 6,600 Library Visits

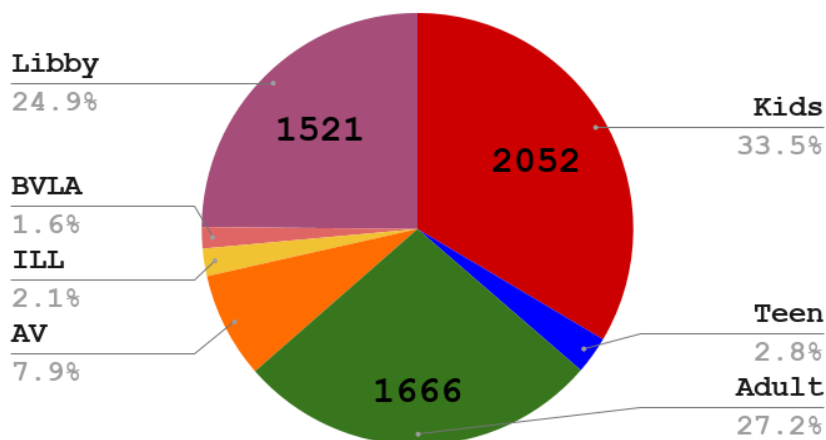


Summer Reading this year was a roaring success! We set a new all-time record number of registrations, surpassing last year's participation by nearly 100 readers!

Our Mission to Mars camp blasted off for its 6th year in partnership with Project Succeed!

Bob collaborated with the Eaton Select Board, Preservation Society, and a local landowner to receive permission to recover and preserve papers remaining in the Eaton Town Vault. Bob will be working this fall to safely retrieve, quarantine, clean, and digitize the papers into the Henney History Room collection.

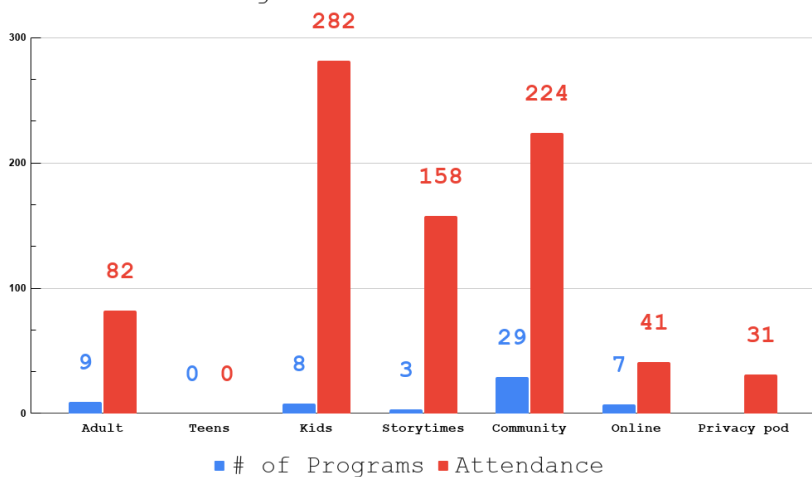
The Friends of the Library and Library Park Committee broke ground on the pavilion and book plaza in the library park this summer.
