CPL Board of Trustees Update Regarding the 3/31/22 Damage to Library Façade

Conway, NH – June 27th, 2022 – The Conway Public Library Board of Trustees report that a condition assessment report has been submitted by Barba+Wheelock of Portland, Maine. Engineers from Barba+Wheelock and Lincoln/Haney Engineering Associates visited the library on May 9th to take measurements and review the existing conditions of the front entrance that was damaged in a drunk driving incident on March 31st.

The purpose of the condition assessment report is to assist in the formulation of the “scope of the work” for the “Request for Proposal” document that will be issued to choose the contractor who will perform the repair work on the façade. The building subcommittee, comprised of Earl Sires, Rob Adair, and Gary MacDonald, will meet in July and discuss the findings of the report. CPL Board of Trustees Chair Julie Laracy said, “With the delivery of this report, a vital first step in the repair process of our beloved building is now complete. We look forward to issuing the RFP with the assistance of our building committee in the near future.”
